


1. Join the Conklin team

3. Purchase or rent some equipment

The cost of getting your business up and running is quite minimal compared to most businesses. Although you can usually rent the equipment you'll need for most jobs you'll quickly find that investing in a few pieces of equipment will more than pay for itself in the first job.

Here's a little list of what you might want to purchase (if you don't already have them) to make your jobs easier and more profitable.



- 1. Backpack Blower \$400
- 2. 4,000 PSI Pressure Washer \$1,000
- 3. Roofing Material Sprayer \$3,000 -\$8,000
- 4. Trailer for materials and equipment \$1,500 \$4,000

You may also need to rent a lift to get the equipment on the roofs you'll be working on although sometimes the building owner will have a lift you can use.

4. Land your first commercial roofing job

Commercial roofing is a \$3.5 billion industry in North America! When total roofing product materials, sales, labor, and installation are taken into account, the industry is worth nearly \$30 billion in terms of total revenues. Opportunities abound!

Start by observing buildings in your town that look like they might have leaky or rusty roofs. Show the building owner how much you can save them by using a Conklin roof restoration system vs. tearing off the existing roof and



replacing it. Show them the great warranties that Conklin offers for trained installers. Show them the sales brochures that Conklin roofing offers and let them read through the reviews from other building owners. Once the customer signs the contract it's time to order the materials.

10,000 Square ft. Roof x \$2.50 Per Square ft.	\$25,000
Labor - 3 Men x 4 Days x \$200 Per Day	-\$2,400
Materials Including Shipping	-\$11,000
Overhead and Rental Costs	-\$800
Net Profit in Four Days	\$10,800

Imagine what you could do with that extra income each month!



8. Bring others onto your team (optional)

This is completely up to you but if you know someone that would benefit from higher income and unlimited growth opportunities consider signing them up as a Conklin contractor.
